Angel Tree Sunday November 18



You can help change the life of a prisoner’s child forever this Christmas! It starts with a gift – and you!

At Christmas we connect with the ones we love. But what if you are a child with a parent in prison—feeling lonely, abandoned, and hurt? Through Angel Tree, a nation-wide program of Prison Fellowship, you can connect a child with their parent behind bars and offer joy and hope to a prisoner’s family.

Here’s How You Can Participate:

On Sunday, November 18, there will be 4 paper “angels” on display in the worship center foyer for each child on the list provided to us by the Prison Fellowship. Three of the angels represent Christmas gift “wishes” from the child. Each child’s 4th angel requests an age-related Bible.

You may choose one or more “angels”, then purchase the gift (\$25 limit please), wrap it, place the “angel” sticker on the package, and return it no later than December 12.

Volunteers will be at the “angel” table to help you to sign up for your selection. Want to help? Contact Wendy Guthrie or the church office.

Our Angel Tree volunteers will deliver the gifts to the children, who all live locally, before Christmas, along with a message of love and the Good News about Jesus—in the name of incarcerated parents.
