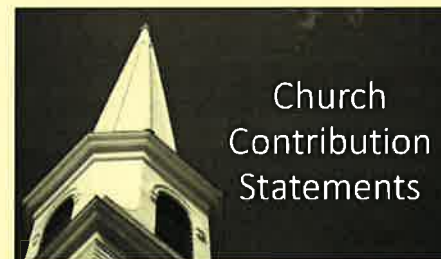

Coming: Weekend of April 7

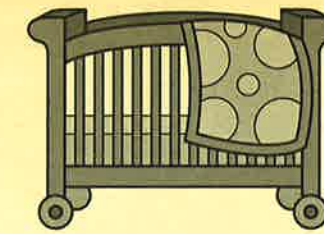
You've waited for it all year and it is almost here - time to get your BBQ cook-off teams together and time to anticipate eatin' some lip smackin' BBQ lunches!
